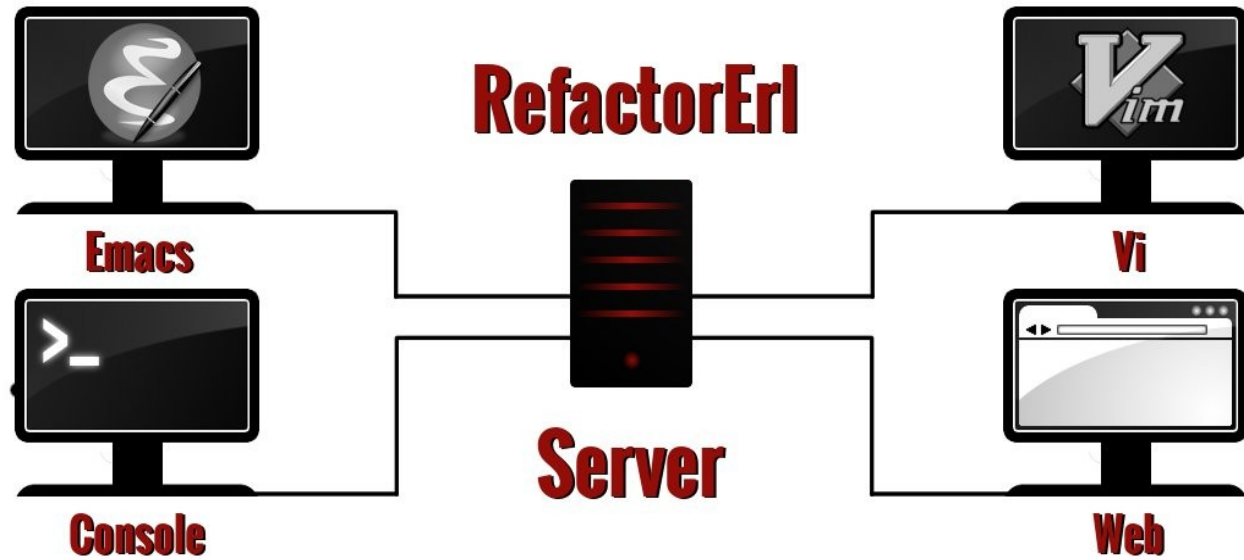

Static Analyses to enable Pattern Discovery

- prototype
- farm, pipe
 - lists:map, list comprehensions
 - composition, call chain
 - functions with farm/pipe-like structure



Refactoring User Interface

present possible pattern candidates to the programmer on demand

performance information for alternative heterogeneous platforms

avoiding unnecessary details
highlight key decisions

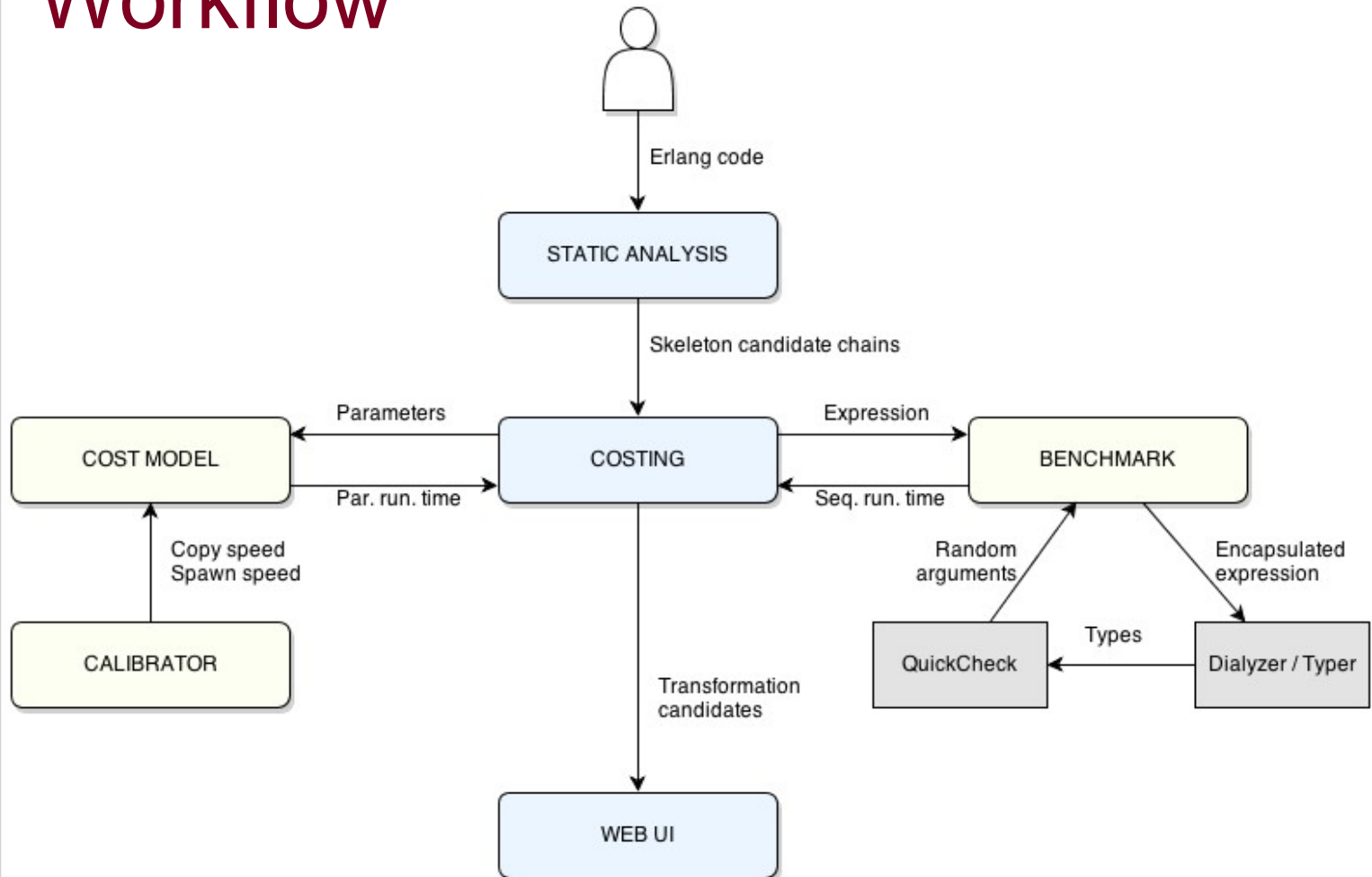
heuristics

- Dynamic compilation and execution of exprs
- Free variables
- Portable funs
- Test data generation (QuickCheck)
